



TURKEY TROT

In university tests, this has been rated one of the best organic fertilizers you can use. It consists of composted deodorized granular turkey manure. Compared to commonly available inorganic fertilizers which only benefit plants, Turkey Trot will build up your soil, making it better each year, providing vital micro-nutrients to everything you grow. Use sparingly--a little goes a long way. Use everywhere--lawns, vegetable and flower beds, when planting bulbs, etc.

Composted for 6-8 weeks at 120-160F

Application Method

As a general guideline, sidedress - or row placement is considered to be three times more effective than broadcast application: Always incorporate fertilizers into the root zone wherever crop cultural management practices allow.

For Garden & Flowerbed

500g - 1 kg per 10 square meter - As a broadcast or sideband around the base of vegetable and plants, 2 applications per growing season are required. At planting time (after the 1st frost) and again in mid summer.

For Potted Plants

Begonias, Geraniums, Petunias, Impatiens,
4" pots - 15 gr, 6" pots 30 gr, 1 gallon pot 40-50 grams. Worked into the soil and watered. Two applications per growing season, spring and mid summer. For all vegetable and garden plants water well after application of Turkey Trot to increase the nutrient activity in the soil.

For Lawns

Approximately 2.5 kg per 10 square meter in the spring and 1 kg per square meter in July and 1 kg per 10 square meter in September.
